

# **WORKSOP DOLPHINS SWIMMING CLUB**

## **MEET RULES**

1. The meet will be held under A.S.A. laws and technical rules
2. Ages are as at date of gala.
3. Entries to the gala are taken on a strictly first come first served basis until the closing date of the gala or the gala capacity has been reached whichever is the sooner.
4. Heats will be seeded on submitted times, swimmers who do not submit times will swim in the first heats, however the organisers reserve the right to slot swimmers where it is felt appropriate.
5. Events will be swum as per programme. Awards may be collected from the trophy stewards as soon as the results have been confirmed. The top boy and girl trophies will be presented prior to the skins final so please listen for announcements.
6. The top boy and girl awards will be made in each age group for the meet best swim based on BAGCAT or GB points where appropriate. Age groups being 9yrs 10yrs 11yrs 12yrs 13yrs 14yrs 15yrs and over.
7. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to ensure they report to the competitor's stewards when their event is called. Please listen for announcements.
8. It is the responsibility of coaches and a parent attending with the swimmers to ensure an acceptable standard of behaviour is maintained in the pool and elsewhere in the building. The promoters reserve the right to exclude any swimmer or spectator not adhering to this condition.
9. The use of all photographic equipment including mobile phones is restricted at all galas, if you wish to take photographs please register your intention with the door stewards and wear the badge that will be issued to you, failure to do so will result in you being excluded from the gala. There is no charge for this so there can be no excuses
10. Anything not covered by the above will be at the discretion of the promoters.

## **IMPORTANT**

This is an international venue and as such is open to the general public; other activities will be taking place in the building at the same time as this gala. If swimmers wish to leave the poolside they must conform to the minimum standard of dress of at least a t-shirt and suitable footwear. Please do not leave items of clothing or other articles unattended as neither the promoters or the pool staff will accept any responsibility for lost or stolen items or any damage to such items.

## **SECURITY**

Due to an increasing number of thefts at open meets may we remind you not to leave anything of even the smallest value unattended, not only do you run the risk of it being stolen but with the current high state of alertness the centres staff will remove anything lying around, destroy it then ask questions.
