Warm-up from 9:30am Start time: 10:15 am

Pre-competitive level, 25m races 7/10yrs	7/8, 9/10yrs

Freestyle 50m event, Open to all 7yrs/over	7/8, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15yrs/over

There will be two sessions with a break to facilitate the Competitive Life Saving Demonstration and 'Try It' session. The estimated break time and second session start time will be set depending on entry level and will be confirmed as soon as possible after the entries have closed

Warm-up: 9:30 to 9.45am Novice and Disability Girls and Boys
9:45 to 10.00am All other participants.

- Entries must be submitted on the forms provided and by the closing date.
- No additional entries will be allowed on the day of meet
- Any swimmer who has entered the event and is unable to take part shall let the organiser know as soon as possible but no later than 6pm Saturday 25th February.
- Swimmers age is as on the day of the festival, 26th February 2012.
- Only Team Manager, Coach or designated representative will be allowed on poolside.
- Swimmers need a T-shirt and drink on poolside all other belongings must be placed in a locker or safe place.
- A participant who has achieved a Midland Qualifying standard in a particular event cannot enter that event, except for the 50m Freestyle which is open with no restrictions.
- A participant is only permitted to enter a maximum of four events.
- Novice competitors who are 7 to 10 yrs old may only compete in the novice 25m events and the 50m Freestyle.
- Award certificates will be given to the first three participants in each age group as shown on this information sheet.
- Results will be posted both on the poolside and balcony area as directed on the day.
- Presentations of certificates will be take place in a designated area on the poolside as directed on the day.
- Swimmers must report to the Holding Area at least one event before their event is due to take place. Instructions on how this will operate will be announced on the day.
- The Referees decision is final
- Any matter arising not covered by the above will be decided by the promoter.
